WHEREAS, the City of Enumclaw, a Washington Municipal Corporation, hereinafter designated "City", is intending to remove and replace existing water line on the westerly margin of 284th Avenue Southeast from Highway 410 (Southeast 448th) to Southeast 464th; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the City to remove and replace the existing line with an eight inch cast iron cement line, water line in the same general location from Highway 410 South to Southeast 464th Street; and

WHEREAS, this line so installed be available to the County of King, a Washington Municipal Corporation, hereinafter designated "County", for use in the King County Park area which lies east of the line and 284th Avenue Southeast; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the County to join in the expense of said line, on terms and conditions hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the County do herein in mutual consideration of the benefits and conditions so contained, agree and bind themselves and their assigns as follows:

- That the City will, as soon as possible, after signing and approval of this agreement by both parties, commence removal and replacement of existing line in the location so designated with the eight inch cast iron concrete pipeline with two crossings of necessary pipe under 284th Avenue Southeast to two locations designated in advance by the County.
- The City will pay the entire expense of acquisition of pipe and installation of same and the County on or before January 10, 1971, will reimburse the City the sum of \$16,000.00 towards the expense of the project, of which \$8,000.00 shall be subject to being recouped by the County on terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth.
  - The County agrees to and shall immediately authorize

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any and all franchise necessary to install the line, including crossings of the County road.

- It is anticipated and expected that additional hookups will be made entitled "latecomer" hook-ups by individuals to this water line as same will be installed and is extended and will be extended and that the City policy in charge for such latecomer hook-ups is \$500.00 per hook-up, and that the City has received or will receive additional sums from Sunset Investors who own extensive holdings south on this line extended, and it is agreed by and between the parties herein that as latecomer payments are made, the Sunset Investors and the County shall each receive one-half of such latecomer charges until such time as the County has received \$8,000.00 of their sum paid herein; the additional \$8,000.00 shall not be relegated for There shall be no interest chargeable on the amount repayment. entitled to latecomer reimbursement, and no definite program of payment, but same shall be paid only so fast and as latecomer hook-ups are accomplished. For administrative purposes, latecomer payments to the County and Sunset Investors as collected by the City shall be made on the February 1, following for each calendar year. The City shall be the party that shall ascertain whether or not any specific hook-up constitutes a latecomer charge.
- This constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and is binding when approved by respective council of the City and the County.

BE IT MOVED that King County Executive John D. Spellman sign the the attached "Agreement on Water Line" as already signed by Mr. Don Miller, City of Enumclaw Mayor, attested to by Margarite Johnson, City Clerk, and Approved as to form, Billy E. Biege, City Attorney, and dated the 9th day of September, 1970.
