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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make grants under 42 U.S.C. 3101, Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965 (P.L. 89-117), Sec. 702, as amended, to local public bodies for basic water and sewer facilities, and

WHEREAS, King County, Washington, through its Department of Public Works manages and operates the King County Sewerage and Drainage District #4, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by said county department that the construction of sanitary sewage collection system is essential to the health and welfare of the residents of the said district area, and soil conditions preclude the use of septic tanks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1. That an application be made to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant which is presently 50% of the total costs and that the balance of the costs is to be made available through revenue bonds and such sources as approved by the County Council.
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file such application with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by said department, to execute such contracts as are required by said department, and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County.
- 3. That the proposed construction is in accordance with the plans developed by said county department and the municipality of Metropolitan Seattle.
