WHEREAS, the following facts have been shown, to-wit:

1. King County is the record owner of County Roads lying within the right of way of SR 18, Jct. SR 5 to South 344th Street Interchange.

2. In the improvement of SR 18, Jct. SR 5 to South 344th Street Interchange by the State of Washington, Department of Highways, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to all County Road rights of way lying within the right of way of said highway project.

3. After due consideration by the County Council of King County, it appears that it will be for the best interests of both King County and the State of Washington that King County convey said County Road rights of way to the State of Washington by Quit Claim Deed for a consideration of Mutual Benefits:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby MOVED by the County Council of King County, Washington, that King County, in accordance with R.C.W. 47.12.040 convey the above mentioned road rights and that the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and deliver to the State of Washington a proper Quit Claim Deed.
