The King County Council declaring:

LAKEMONT BOULEVARD (Newcastle Road to FAI 90)

A Necessity:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as LAKEMONT BOULEVARD

be established not less than 60 feet nor more than 120 feet in width, not less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:


Commencing at a point on the centerline of Newcastle Road in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., said point being Station 95+65.53 as surveyed by King County Road Survey No. 14-24-5-12; thence in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 8987.12 feet to a terminus at a point which is S.82°05'34.6"E. a distance of 269.564 feet from the Northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

8987.12 feet = 1.70 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
