THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

18th Avenue NW (NW 195th Street to NW 197th Street)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as 18th Avenue NW be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerlines:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of NW 195th Street in Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 3 East, W.M., said point being King County Engineers Station 22+09.03 as surveyed by King County Engineers Survey No. 2-26-3-40; Thence northerly 515.38 feet to a terminus at the intersection of NW 197th Street, said terminus being King County Engineers Station 1+46.69 as surveyed by King County Engineers Survey No. 2-26-3-33.

515.38 Feet = 0.10 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
