WHEREAS, the State of Washington is desirous of acquiring a certain parcel of land for the purpose of building a bridge as part of the State Highway system; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-County River Improvement District may have some indeterminate interest in such land; and

WHEREAS, the extent of the Inter-County River Improvement District is highly uncertain and there is a doubt as to whether in fact, the Inter-County River Improvement District has any interest at all in such land; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County to convey whatever interest the Inter-County River Improvement District has to the State Highway Department: NOW

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the King County Council, that the King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed, under which the Inter-County Improvement District conveys it is interest in the land, which is described in the attached copy, to the State Highway Department.
