

MOTION NO. 0406NO. 70-794

WHEREAS, The Vashon Veteran's Memorial Foundation, Inc. own certain lands on Vashon Island known as Vashon Memorial Park described as follows:

The North 396 feet of the South 495 feet of the West 660 feet of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, Twn 23N, Range 3 EWM, King County, Washington --- Less beginning at a point 295 feet North of the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 29; Thence East at right angles 300 feet; Thence North 200 feet; Thence W 300 feet; Thence South 200 feet to the Point of Beginning EXCEPT the West 30 feet for road; and EXCEPT that portion conveyed to King County under Auditor's File #823388 for Charles Schafer Road.

AND WHEREAS, the Vashon Memorial Foundation is desirous of donating and conveying said lands to King County for park purposes,
AND

WHEREAS the King County Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County, that King County, accept said premises described herein as a public park to be known as John Ober Memorial Park,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of King County, State of Washington does hereby approve of the acceptance of these lands described herein, and authorize the County Executive to enter into an agreement with the Vashon Memorial Foundation, Inc., to effect the transfer of subject premises to King County
