WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for a legal adviser to the Department of Public Safety in their overall operation and it is in the public interest to do so, and

WHEREAS, the County Council also recognizes the need for those aforementioned grant funds to create the position of a legal adviser within the Department of Public Safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That an application be made to the Law and Justice Planning Office for a grant for the purpose of creating the position of a legal adviser in the Department of Public Safety.
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and to file such application with the Law and Justice Planning Office, and to execute such contracts as are required by said office.
3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County.
4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
