

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and,

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to improve the communication system of the Department of Public Safety, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that an improved communication system is in the best interest of the general public and will provide greater protection and safety to the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington for assistance in establishing the King County Law Enforcement Radio Communication System.

2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Law & Justice Planning Office and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County.

4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
