THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

6th Avenue South (South 320th Street to South line of
Springwood Park No. 2)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of
King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as
6th Avenue South

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of
such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at a point on the centerline of South 320th Street
said centerline being also the south line of Section 8,
Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., 754.11 feet westerly
of the south quarter corner of said Section 8, Thence N 1°
11' 08" E, a distance of 329.61 feet to a terminus, said
terminus being the intersection of the centerline of said
6th Avenue South with the south line of Springwood Park No. 2
as recorded in Vol. 82 of Plats, page 25, records of King
County, Washington.

329.61 Feet = .0076 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said
roadway along the course and description set forth is a public
necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public
Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as
required by law.
