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3 THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

4 SE 63rd Street from High Point Refuse Site Access Road
5 (279th Avenue SE) to Summit View Estates (288th Place SE)

6 A NECESSITY:

7 WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King
8 County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

9 279th Avenue SE, SE 63rd Street, and 288th Place SE
10 be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of
11 such width each side of the following described centerline;

12 beginning at engineers station 68+66.50 on the ("A" Line) of
13 the High Point Refuse Site Access Road (279th Avenue SE) as
14 surveyed by King County Engineers Survey No. 25-24-6-4, in
15 the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Twp. 24 N., Rge. 7 E.W.M.,
16 King County, Washington, thence in a northerly, easterly,
17 and northerly direction for a distance of 3,789.96 feet to a
18 terminus on the easterly plat boundary of Summit View Estates
19 at a point 79.48 feet northerly of the southeasterly corner
20 of said Summit View Estates, as recorded in Vol. 75 of Plats,
21 pages 18 and 19, records of King County, Washington, said
22 terminus also being engineers station 37+89.96 of King
23 County Engineer's Survey No. 19-24-7-2.

24 3,789.96 Feet = 0.72 Mile

25 The King County Council finds that the establishment of said
26 roadway along the course and description set forth is a public
27 necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public
28 Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same
29 as required by law.
