KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

IVOL 6 IRME 438

AVONDALE ROAD EXTENSION

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

AVONDALE ROAD EXTENSION

be established in a strip of land not more than 265 feet and not less than 133 feet in width having not more than 130 feet and not less than 60 feet on the left and not more than 135 feet and not less than 70 feet on the right of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of S.R. 520 said point being S.57°57'09"W. a distance of 1873.19 feet from the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence northerly 2,538.47 feet to a terminus on the centerline of Avondale Road, said terminus being S.37°28'42"E. a distance of 1,774.45 feet from the southeast corner of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

2,538.47 feet = 0.48 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
