A MOTION relating to Fort Lawton, Military Post, Seattle, Washington, and repealing Motion No. 0383.

WHEREAS the United States has abandoned all use of Fort Lawton as a Military Post and otherwise and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney, County of King, has determined that King County has no legal interest in the title of the land so deeded to the United States Government as now designated Fort Lawton, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle is proceeding to obtain such lands for the purposes and benefit of the public of King County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that the County shall not make an effort to lay claim on any properties within the Fort Lawton complex and that it will encourage and assist the City of Seattle in obtaining such properties for public use.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED that King County Motion No. 0383 be hereby repealed.
