WHEREAS, the Seattle Area Industrial Council has requested an appropriation of \$3,000 to perform preliminary work leading to a federal application for an in-depth feasibility study of the Lower Duwamish development project; and

WHEREAS, said Lower Duwamish development project is deemed to be of benefit in terms of the economic development of the entire county; and

WHEREAS, the 1971 County budget includes an allocation of \$12,400 for general services provided by the Seattle Area Industrial Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of King County as follows:

1. That the request for an appropriation of \$3,000 to the Seattle Area Industrial Council be approved.
2. That the County Executive is hereby requested to make such budget revisions as are necessary within general Special Programs Accounts in the 1971 budget to increase the total allocation for the Seattle Area Industrial Council to \$15,400.
