THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

South 180th Street (32nd Avenue South to 40th Avenue South)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as South 180th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence in a easterly direction a distance of 2070.43 feet to a terminus on the centerline of South 179th Street said terminus being S 59° 14' 40" W. a distance of 1337.35 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 34, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.

2070.43 Feet = 0.39 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
