THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

A NECESSITY:

Novelty Hill Road (Avondale Road to Engineers Sta. 200+00)

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as Novelty Hill Road

be established not more than 84' and not less than 60' in width, having not more than 42' and not less than 30' on each side of the following described centerline.

Beginning at a point which bears S 73° 51' 13" E a distance of 1808.54 feet from the NW corner of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 6 East., W.M., said point being on the centerline of the Avondale Road; thence northeasterly a distance of 19,317.66 feet to a terminus on the centerline of the Novelty Hill Road, said terminus bearing S 87° 47' 31" E a distance of 1094.38 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 34, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

19,317.66 Feet = 3.66 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
