AGREEMENT PROVIDING FOR REVIEWING, REVISING, ADOPTING, AND PUBLISHING THE KING COUNTY CODE

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this ______day of _______, 1971 by and between the County of King, State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and Book Publishing Company, hereinafter referred to as the "Company",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County intends to review, revise, adopt, and publish the King County Code pursuant to the requirements of the King County Charter; and

WHEREAS, to implement the above stated purpose the County desires to retain the professional services of the Company;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS COVENANTED AND AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

In consideration of the payment to be made in accordance with the following schedule by the County to the Company, the Company agrees to:

- (1) Provide suggested language for revisions to the existing code required by the Charter. The Company will use its previous analysis by John Oswald as a guide for changes. The Company will call attention to possible constitutional and statutory conflicts, but will not provide language for changes except as required by the Charter.
- (2) Publish one hundred seventy (170) copies of each title after it is adopted by the County.

- (3) Retain one hundred (100) copies of each title until all titles have been adopted; then index, insert tabbed divider pages, assemble and deliver to the County one hundred (100) King County Codes in binders of the same kind and quality as the Richmond City Code binder submitted as a sample.
- (4) To provide supplement service for two years on a quarterly, semi-annual, or annual basis at the price in the following schedule.

The County agrees to:

- (1) Review the Company's work, adopt each title and return the adopted title to the Company according to the schedule below.
- (2) (a) To pay the Company \$18.50 per page for reprinted titles, with the exception of index and table pages which will be paid for at the Company's regular supplement price of \$15.50 per page. Payment for title reprints is due and payable on delivery.
- (b) \$8.75 each for one hundred (100) binders imprinted with the title of the code as follows: "King County Code".
- (c) \$170.00 for one hundred (100) sets of tabbed divider pages. Each additional set of tabbed divider pages -\$1.00.
 - (d) Supplement pages: \$15.50 per page.

Time Schedule:

It is the intention of both parties to complete all work within a maximum time period of fifteen months from the date of this agreement. To accomplish this, it is agreed that the Company will complete editorial and

legal work on at least two titles each month. It is further agreed that the County will adopt each title within forty-five (45) d 7s of receipt of the Company's work.

The Company will then print and deliver completed and adopted titles after adoption by the County.
