The Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in this matter was appealed, and the Council has reviewed the record

The Council concurs in the findings contained on Pages 5,6, and 7 of the Examiner's report dated May 18, 1971.

The Council makes the following conclusions:

and written appeal arguments.

- 1) The proposed reclassification conforms to the policies and criteria of the Comprehensive Plan for Community Business areas.
- 2) The reclassification will not be unreasonably incompatible with nor detrimental to affected properties and the general public.
- 3) The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's decision denying the application was based on an error in judgement.

The Council does hereby reverse the recommendation of the Examiner and does hereby indicate its approval of the reclassification of the subject property from BN, RM 900 and RM 1800 to BC, subject to satisfaction of the following conditions within six months from the date of this motion:

- A. Certification by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner that the Technical Committee has approved applicant's plans for landscaping, drainage, and building design. Building design shall be in accordance with Exhibit #14 entered at the Public Hearing before the Examiner.
- B. Certification by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner that the applicant has posted with the Department of Planning a Performance Bond in the amount to be stipulated by the Technical Committee based upon the approved plans for landscaping, drainage, and building design.
