

## 1 KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON

2 MOTION NO. 554

3  
4 A MOTION of the County Council of King County,  
5 Washington, retaining counsel for certain  
6 services in connection with the sale, issuance  
7 and delivery of Solid Waste General Obligation  
8 Bonds of the County in the principal amount of  
9 \$975,000.

10 WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the best interests  
11 of King County and its inhabitants that the County acquire new  
12 and used replacement equipment and improve facilities of the  
13 Solid Waste Division; and

14 WHEREAS, it is further deemed necessary that nationally  
15 recognized attorneys experienced in such matters be retained  
16 as bond counsel to participate with the King County Prosecuting  
17 Attorney in drafting the ordinances, notices and other documents  
18 necessary for the issuance, sale and delivery of such bonds, and  
19 to give their opinion as to the validity thereof at the time of  
20 their sale;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:  
22 that Roberts, Shefelman, Lawrence, Gay, Moch and Harper attorneys  
23 at law of Seattle, Washington are hereby employed by the County  
24 in drafting the ordinances, notices and other documents required  
25 by the County in connection with the issue and sale of \$975,000  
26 par value "General Obligation Solid Waste Equipment Replacement  
27 and Facility Improvement Bonds, 1971;"

28 THAT the services to be rendered by said law firm is  
29 participation in the drafting of all ordinances, notices and  
30 other documents through the issuance and sale of the bonds, and  
31 the furnishing of an approved legal opinion upon the validity  
32 of such bonds at the time of the delivery thereof to the purchasers;

33 THAT the County shall pay Roberts, Shefelman, Lawrence, Gay,  
Moch and Harper the sum of \$1,750 together with any actual out-of-

1 pocket expenses incurred by it in rendering such services other  
2 than office overhead, said payment to be made out of the proceeds  
3 of the sale of such bonds when issued; and

4 THAT the County shall furnish Roberts, Shefelman, Lawrence,  
5 Gay, Moch and Harper a complete certified transcript of all  
6 proceedings had in connection with the issuance of the bonds in  
7 order to enable said firm to furnish its approving opinion as to  
8 the validity thereof at the time of the sale of such bonds.
