WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to establish in the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney an investigation and community relations expert to provide two-way communication with the public, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the establishment of such a program is in the best public interest,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and file a grant application with the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, for grant funds to operate the Community Relations Program in the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney.

2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such contracts as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

4. That the United States of America, the Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance

with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
