MOTION

A Motion indicating the Council's disapproval of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's recommendation to deny Ole Sather's application as designated by the Department of Planning as File No. 217-71-P.

The decision of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in this matter having been appealed the Council finds:

- 1. The subject property is suitably located for a day nursery.
- 2. There is a limited site visibility due to curves that occur in front of the subject property that requires particular care in laying out ingress and egress.

The Council concludes therefore:

- 1. The Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's decision recommending denial of the applicant's request for zone reclassification from RS 7200 to RM 900 was based on an error in judgement.
- 2. The application for rezoning of the subject property to RM 900 should be approved subject to a Planned Unit Development.

The Council does hereby reject the decision of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner and does hereby approve Applicant's request for a reclassification of the subject property to RM 900 subject to the following conditions.

- 1. An application for preliminary approval of a Planned Unit Development which meets the requirements of the Department of Planning, shall be submitted to that Department within six months from the date of this motion.
- 2. The applicant shall obtain final approval of a planned Unit Development within twelve months from the date of this motion.
