

WHEREAS, The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make grants under 42 U.S. C. 3101, Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965 (P.L. 89-117), Sec. 702, as amended, to local public bodies for basic water and sewer facilities, and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 4, Section 7, of Ordinance 00302 requires King County to undertake the appropriate agreements to provide assistance in the development of the BREAKTHROUGH project, and

WHEREAS, King County, Washington, through its Department of Public Works has determined that the construction of storm drainage system is essential to the health and welfare of the King County residents in and near the BREAKTHROUGH site,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That the County Executive is authorized to submit an application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant to provide 50% of the total construction cost of the proposed storm drainage system.
2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

4. That the United States of America and the Department of Housing and Urban Development be, and they hereby are, assured of full compliance by King County with the regulations of said Federal Department effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
