

MOTION NO. 614

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner and modifying a condition contained in the Examiner's report on the application of Parker and Associates for an unclassified use permit, Department of Planning File No. 309-71-P.

WHEREAS, THE Zoning and Subdivision Examiner has entered a report of recommendation on the application of Parker and Associates for an unclassified use permit, Department of Planning File No. 309-71-P, and

WHEREAS, an appeal from the Examiner's recommendation was filed by Mr. Elmer H. Ray, and

WHEREAS, the Council has examined the written appeal arguments and the record in this matter,

NOW THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:

The Council concurs with the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendation contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, dated June 29, 1971 with the following modification:

The term of the unclassified use permit shall be four (4) years from the effective date of the ordinance granting such permit. All extractive and processing operations on the site shall cease at the termination of the permit. The applicant shall complete rehabilitation of the final operating area of the site within one (1) year from the termination of the permit.
