

MOTION NO. 618

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for a meaningful vocational training program and placement service for the physically and mentally handicapped to maximize each individuals's employment potential and reduce the likelihood of these people of acquiring a police record,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County Washington, as follows:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, on behalf of Services Inc., a non-profit corporation dedicated to teaching the handicapped people a marketable trade.

2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with Services Inc., for the implementation of the project.
