A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for a program for quick and "intensive" intervention for girls expressing delinquent behavior or undergoing crisis situations that may require short-term residential care and counseling to prevent them from becoming wards of the court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, on behalf of Lutheran Family and Child Service of Washington, a non-profit corporation organized to meet child welfare needs regardless of race, creed or color.

2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with the Lutheran Family and Child Service, for the implementation of the project.
