

MOTION NO. 649

1 A MOTION establishing a formula by which Federal funds
2 shall be distributed to meet requirements of the
3 Emergency Employment Act of 1971 and Administrative
4 Regulations of the U.S. Department of Labor.

4 WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has created the
5 Emergency Employment Act of 1971 and appropriated funds thereto for
6 purposes of generating employment and satisfying unmet public needs,
7 and;

8 WHEREAS, King County, Washington has been designated a program
9 agent for the Administration of funds made available under the
10 1971 Act, and;

11 WHEREAS, rules for administration of the Act were promulgated
12 by the U. S. Department of Labor and require Program Agents to
13 share such funds "equitably" with other governmental agencies
14 within the jurisdictional boundaries of King County, outside
15 Seattle, and;

16 WHEREAS, distribution of the granted money should be uniformly
17 administered to ensure fair and equal distribution of Federal money;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Council of King County
19 that the following considerations shall be applied by the County
20 Administrative Officer in determining distribution of these funds:

- 21 1. Population within each governmental jurisdiction.
- 22 2. Unemployment within each governmental jurisdiction.
- 23 3. Public employment of each governmental jurisdiction.
- 24 4. Priority of projects within king County.
- 25 5. A ratio shall be established from the above four factors
26 by the County Administrator's office and presented to the
27 County Council, for approval or modification, and funds
28 shall be allocated accordingly.

29 FURTHER, BE IT ORDERED THAT eligibility shall be limited to
30 units of general government in the Phase III funding distribution
31 except as specifically approved by the Council prior to submission
32 of further applications to the U. S. Department of Labor.
