A MOTION indicating the Council's rejection of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's recommendation and its approval of the amended application of Preston Mill Co., et al, Department of Planning File No. 215-71-ZA for reclassification of certain land from RA to CM and B-1.

WHEREAS, the decision of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in this matter has been appealed and the application of

WHEREAS, the Council finds as follows:

Preston Mill Co., et al, has been amended, and

- (1) The CM zoning now existing in the Preston area is substantially committed and not available to the applicant;
- (2) The I-90 interchange at Preston will take some of the Preston Mill's log storage ponds and will limit the expansion of the mill in its present location;
- (3) The Echo Lake Interchange is highly strategic for highwayuser facilities which are permitted in the B-1 zone and also strategic to the industrial trucking requirements of the applicant;
- (4) The CM classification has development controls which can be utilized by the County to protect the scenic quality of the two major highway corridors involved; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes therefore as follows:

- (1) The Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's decision denying the applicant's request for reclassification was based on an error in judgement;
- __(2) Additional CM and B-l zoning is needed in the general area to meet basic industrial and commercial land requirements; and
- (3) The reclassification sought by the applicant would carry out and help to implement the official policies and objectives for the development of King County,
