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31 32 A Motion indicating the Council's approval of the reclassification of certain properties which are the subject of Department of Planning Files No. 125-70-P and 126-70-P, subject to final approval of planned unit developments therefore.

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WHEREAS, on March 9, 1971 the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner filed a Report and Recommendation with the Council in relation to the applications for reclassification designated as Planning Files No. 125-70-P and 126-70-P; and

WHEREAS, Council action on the Examiner's recommendation was postponed pending receipt of a sub-area zoning study by the City of Kirkland, King County Environmental Development Commission and the Department of Planning; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of said sub-area zoning study, on December 20, 1971 the Council adopted Motion No. 693, a statement of policy on the so-called "N. E. 85th Street Corridor", of which area the subject properties are a part;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the King County Council:

- (1) The Council hereby concurs in and adopts the Findings and Conclusions contained in the Examiner's Report of March 9, 1971; and
- (2) The Council hereby approves the reclassification of the subject properties from SR and SR (Potential RM 1800) to BC subject to satisfaction of the following conditions:
 - (a) Final approval of a Planned Unit Development for each of said properties within twenty-four months from the date of this motion, the application for preliminary approval of which shall meet the filing requirements of the Department of
