WHEREAS: The Federal Government thru the Emergency Employment

(PEP) Program has granted King County sufficient funds to add

105 uniformed patrolmen to the Public Safety Division; and

WHEREAS: The conditions of the grant require the immediate hiring of qualified personnel; and

WHEREAS: The Sheriff's Civil Service Commission has already interviewed, tested, and tentatively accepted enough candidates to fill all but approximately 25 of these portions; and

WHEREAS: Other Departments of County government have also hired approximately 315 individuals under the PEP PROGRAM;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The King County Council recognizing fully the urgency of interviewing, testing, and accepting the additional 25 authorized uniform personnel, does hereby request that all departments of County government fully cooperate thru the loaning of required personnel in order that the Sheriff's Civil Service Commission may proceed with due haste toward the goal of increasing the enrollment of uniformed personnel to the maximum number authorized under the PEP grant.
