

1 PROPOSED MOTION relating to Sheriff's Civil Service Commission.

2 WHEREAS: The Federal Government thru the Emergency Employment
3 (PEP) Program has granted King County sufficient funds to add
4 105 uniformed patrolmen to the Public Safety Division; and

5 WHEREAS: The conditions of the grant require the immediate
6 hiring of qualified personnel; and

7 WHEREAS: The Sheriff's Civil Service Commission has already
8 interviewed, tested, and tentatively accepted enough candidates to
9 fill all but approximately 25 of these portions; and

10 WHEREAS: Other Departments of County government have also
11 hired approximately 315 individuals under the PEP PROGRAM;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The King County Council
13 recognizing fully the urgency of interviewing, testing, and
14 accepting the additional 25 authorized uniform personnel, does
15 hereby request that all departments of County government fully
16 cooperate thru the loaning of required personnel in order that the
17 Sheriff's Civil Service Commission may proceed with due haste toward
18 the goal of increasing the enrollment of uniformed personnel to the
19 maximum number authorized under the PEP grant.
