PROPOSED MOTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION BY KING COUNTY TO THE BOEING EMPLOYEES' GOOD NEIGHBOR FUND FOR FUNDING CAPITAL COSTS OF A MOBILE HEALTH UNIT

WHEREAS, Residents of King County outside of the City of Seattle are confronted with transportation problems in using medical services in the county, and

WHEREAS, Unemployment and public assistance levels are very high in the Health Districts outside Seattle, thereby compounding the problem of availability of needed services, and

WHEREAS, Significant information is available which indicates that both local and national problems of health service to infants and youth create long term health hazards which are avoidable through early diagnosis and treatment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the King County Council as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the Boeing Employees' Good Neighbor Fund requesting the capital monies necessary to construct and equip a mobile health unit.
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the Boeing Employees' Good Neighbor Fund.
3. That such mobile health equipment is to be used under the direction of the Seattle-King County Health Department for pediatric diagnosis and treatment or referral.
4. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documentation as may be required by the Boeing Employees' Good Neighbor Fund.
