PROPOSED MOTION AUTHORIZING KING COUNTY TO APPLY TO THE WASHINGTON STATE TRAFFIC COMMISSION FOR MONIES TO FUND THE POSITION OF A TRAFFIC SAFETY COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, Many departments in King County are concerned with problems of traffic safety and education, and

WHEREAS, There now exists no mechanism to systematically coordinate their efforts, and

WHEREAS, A comprehensive Traffic Safety Plan would be desirable for King County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the King County Council as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute an application with the Washington State Traffic Commission requesting the monies necessary to establish a Traffic Safety Coordinator position.
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the Washington State Traffic Commission.
3. That such Traffic Safety Coordinator develop a comprehensive traffic safety plan and report such plan to the County Executive or his designee.
4. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documentation as may be required by the Washington State Traffic Commission.
