A motion providing the County Executive with the authority to execute and submit a grant application to the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$41,253, for the operation of the YMCA Youth Action Program in the White Center area.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 and the Juvenile Delinquency Prevention and Control Act of 1968, provide for the making of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for juvenile delinquency prevention programs in the White Center area and to provide potentially delinquent youth in this area with counseling, tutorial assistance and an opportunity to develop their potential for leadership through productive and socially constructive activities, and

WHEREAS, the Youth Action Program of the Seattle Metropolitan YMCA has proven to be successful in reducing juvenile delinquency in other areas of the County and,

WHEREAS, the County Council endorses the application proposal developed by the Metropolitan YMCA,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office,
  Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, on behalf of the Seattle Metropolitan YMCA.
- 2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.
- 3. That the Law and Justice Planning Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by

3	enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with
4	the Seattle Metropolitan YMCA for the implementation of the
