

1 A MOTION relating to the King County Board
2 of Appeals.

3 WHEREAS, certain allegations have been made against two
4 members of the King County Board of Appeals, and

5 WHEREAS, such allegations tend to imply that there may have
6 been some violations of county or state law, and

7 WHEREAS, the King County Council has not received any written
8 charges of misconduct against any member of the Board of Appeals,
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the King County Council, in accordance with Section
11 710, King County Charter, has no authority to act without written
12 charges, and

13 WHEREAS, the citizens of King County have every right to be
14 informed if there are any violations,

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 The King County Council immediately review the operation and
17 actions of the Board of Appeals and request the following:

- 18 1. The records of the actions of the Board of Appeals;
- 19 2. A report from the Commercial Appeals Team of the
20 Assessor's Office;
- 21 3. Written charges, if any, against any member or members of
22 the Board of Appeals;
- 23 4. A recommendation from the Board of Ethics as to what
24 action, if any, the County Council should take.
