1 P R O C L A M A T I O N

2 WHEREAS, the annual celebration of Brotherhood Week, to be
3 held February 20 through February 27, 1972, is sponsored by the
4 National Conference of Christians and Jews; and

5 WHEREAS, the National Conference of Christians and Jews is
6 diligently working to establish a social order in which the
7 religious ideals of brotherhood and justice shall become the
8 standards of human relationships, and

9 WHEREAS, the purpose of Brotherhood Week is to symbolize
10 renewed dedication to the ideals of greater tolerance, understand-
11 ing, friendship, and cooperation among all our citizens, and
12 greater respect for the differences and beliefs of our people,

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County
14 that in recognition of the above stated goals and purposes, the
15 period of February 20 through February 27, 1972, be proclaimed
16 as BROTHERHOOD WEEK. All citizens, public and private institutions,
17 and business and industrial organizations are urged to share in
18 this observance and to rededicate ourselves to the practice of
19 brotherhood of man under the Fatherhood of God.
