AMENDED MOTION NO. 7.1

A MOTION requesting an investigation of the need for facilities for handling mentally disturbed prisoners.

WHEREAS, it has been estimated that a significant percentage of the prisoners held in the King County Jail are mentally disturbed; and,

WHEREAS, the King County Jail lacks adequate facilities to care for mentally disturbed persons; and,

WHEREAS, an individual's condition may be worsened due to the lack of facilities and treatment; and,

WHEREAS, some individuals have become violent and caused extensive damage as a result of lack of treatment,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County that the King County Mental Health - Mental Retardation Board and the Washington Association for Mental Health, under the direction of the Citizens' Health and Safety Committee, are hereby requested to conduct a study and submit recommendations of the need for facilities and personnel for the adequate identification and care of mentally disturbed prisoners.
