A motion providing the County Executive with authority to execute and submit a grant application to the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office in the amount of \$399,222.16 for assistance in further implementing the King County Law Enforcement Radio Communication System.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and,

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to improve the communication system of the Department of Public Safety, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that an improved communication system is in the best interest of the general public and will provide greater protection and safety to the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington for assistance in continuing implementation of the King County Law Enforcement Radio Communication System.
- 2. That the County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.
- 3. That the Law and Justice Planning Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County.
