2 A MOTION approving the planning process and establishing  
3 administrative procedures for the East County Area Zoning  
4 Program.

5 WHEREAS, in accordance with the objectives of Ordinance 263 to  
6 comprehensively plan for and draft statements and maps of land use policy,  
7 the Environmental Development Commission and Department of Planning have  
8 initiated area zoning studies for the East King County Area.

9 NOW THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:

10 1. The King County Council hereby concurs with the concept that  
11 the Environmental Development Commission will maximize the citizen  
12 viewpoint and will provide guidelines for area zoning recommendations. The  
13 King County Council further concurs in the East King County planning process  
14 (illustration attached) which is designed to encourage citizen expression.

15 2. The King County Council intends that any zoning proposal which  
16 pertains to properties under a current area zoning program will have been  
17 presented to and considered by the Environmental Development Commission.

18 3. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is hereby instructed to  
19 not schedule hearings on applications for reclassification, planned unit dev-  
20 elopments or special permits in areas under the East County area zoning  
21 program until adoption of the area zoning by the King County Council.

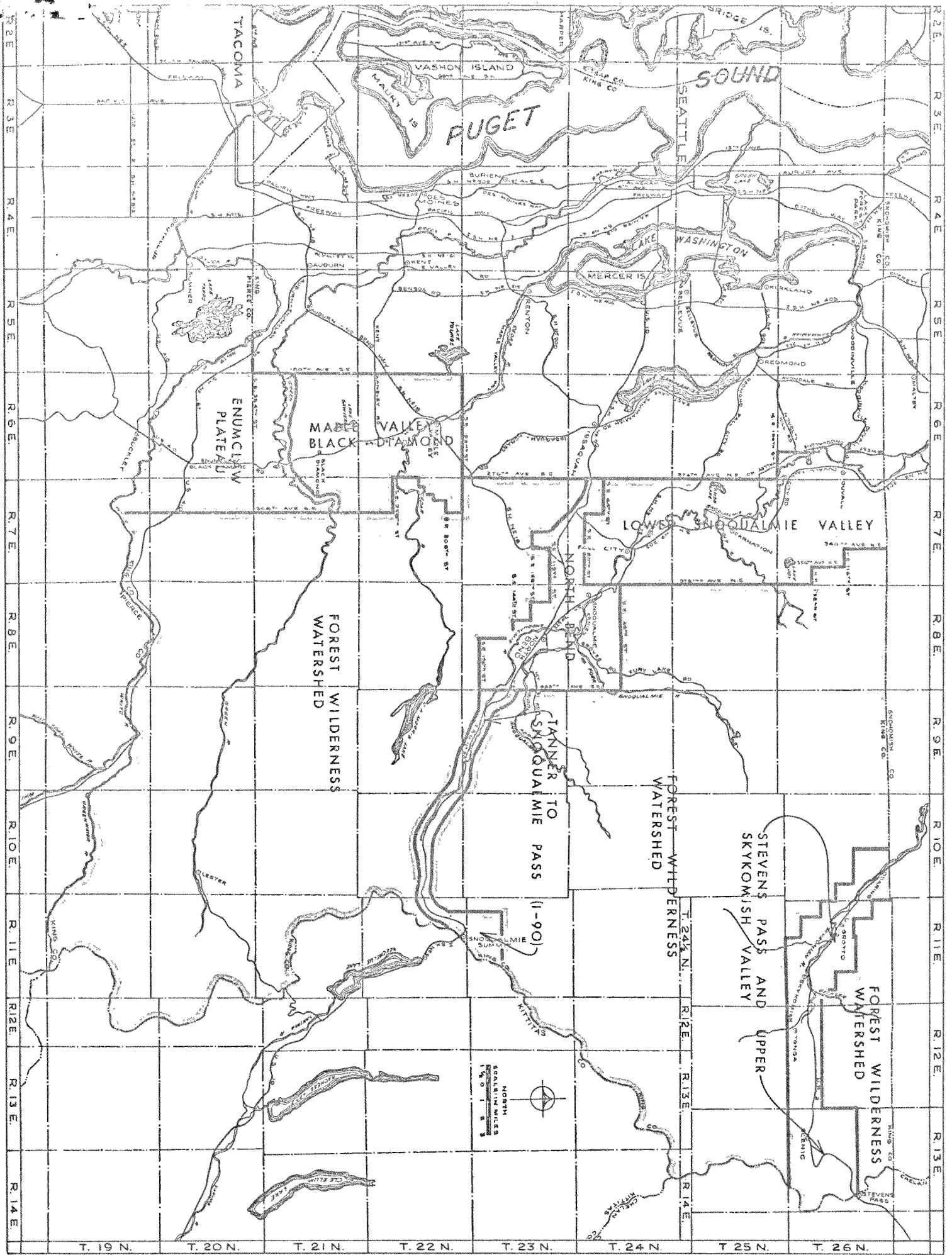

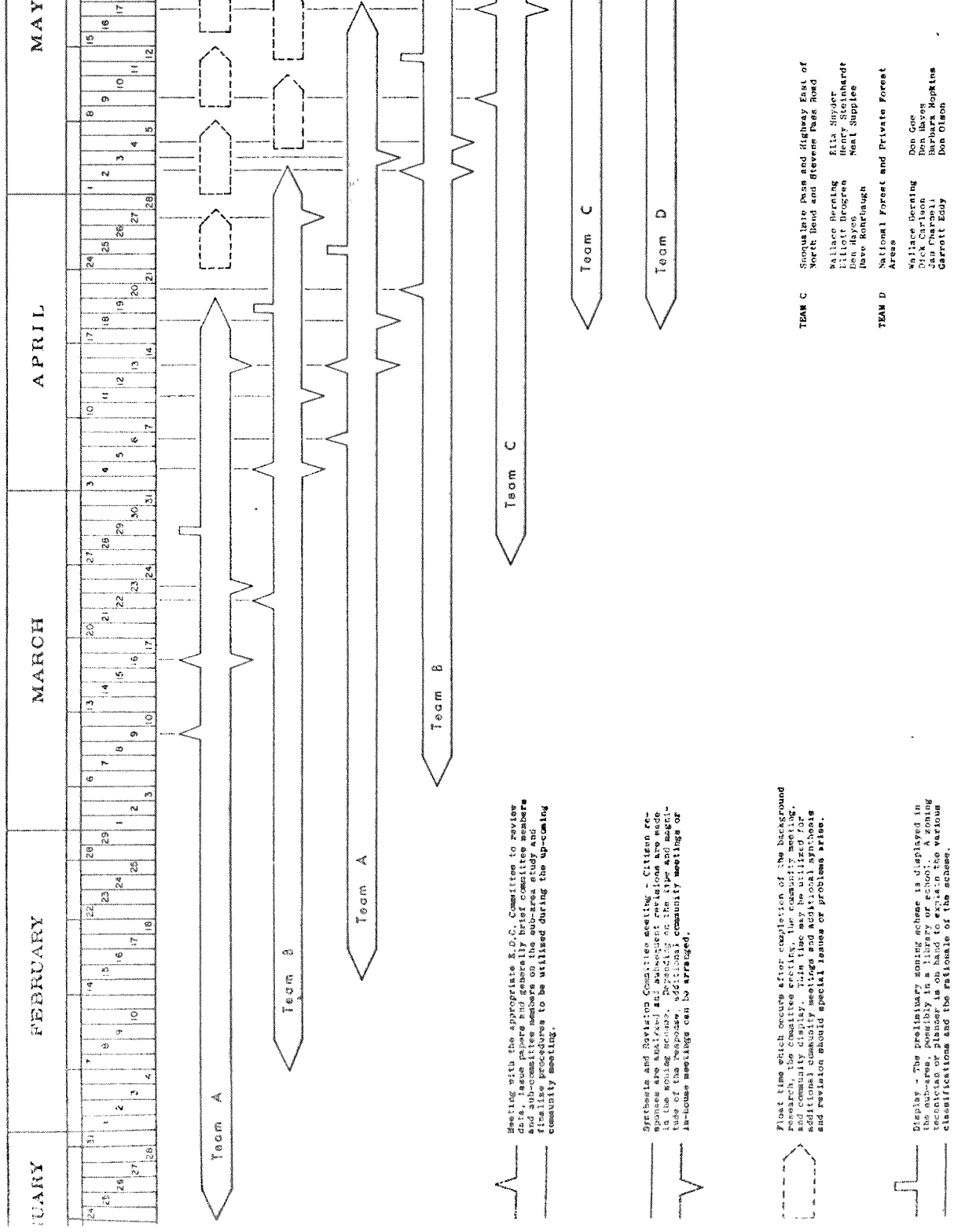
