

MOTION
NO. 775

A MOTION authorizing the submission of a grant application by King County to the National Institute for Alcohol and Alcohol Abuse, Department of Health, Education and Welfare on behalf of Seattle-King County Department of Public Health.

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County area has an unusually high incidence of alcoholism, and

WHEREAS, the area has a wide variety of agencies concerned with alcoholism, and

WHEREAS, there is the need to establish a Central Alcoholism Agency to develop services that are comprehensive in substance and available as needed, and

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the regulations of the Department of Housing and Urban Development effectuating that Title, provide that no person shall be discriminated against because of race, color, or national origin in the use of the land acquired and/or developed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the National Institute for Alcohol and Alcohol Abuse for approximately \$1,002,178 to establish a Central Alcoholism Agency.
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as may be required by the National Institute for Alcohol and Alcohol Abuse.
3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and documentation as may be required by the National Institute for Alcohol and Alcohol Abuse.
