A MOTION accepting the 138th Avenue S. E. (Maple Valley in Renton) Task Force Report and recommending the King County Department of Public Works to study the suggested alternative routes and their impacts.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council accepts the report of the 138th Avenue S. E. Task Force and thanks the members for their diligent efforts,

FURTHER, it requests the King County Department of Public Works to analyze the report's recommended alternatives in detail to ascertain their engineering feasibility and impact on the environment, established neighborhoods, school children's traffic patterns (present and future), community access, vehicular and pedestrian safety, present needs and long-range requirements, and all costs,

FURTHER it requests the King County Department of Public Works to give heavy consideration in its study to the other recommendations in the report, especially that as the engineering evaluation is proceeding, a Citizens' Advisory Committee be formed and kept advised of progress, retaining some of the original members of the Task Force,

FURTHER, it requests the Department of Public Works to report back to the King County Council its comparative evaluations no later than December 18, 1972.
