A MOTION authorizing an easement for ingress and egress across the Cadman Pit Site.

WHEREAS, Russell Ingersol and others have requested a non-exclusive easement for ingress and egress and for hauling of materials by truck from properties which they own in Section 7, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the easement for ingress and egress crosses certain lands owned by King County known as the Cadman Pit Site, and as described is over the existing access road to the Cadman Pit Site, and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the easement agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", Russell Ingersol, et al, agrees to construct and maintain the easement road in satisfactory condition to enable the passage of vehicular traffic on said easement right-of-way as a consideration for the granting of the easement, and

WHEREAS, investigation and study by the Department of Public Works and the Office of Property and Purchasing reveals that it would be to the County's advantage to grant Russell Ingersol, et al, the requested easement,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary easement agreement granting to Russell Ingersol, et al, a non-exclusive easement across the Cadman Pit Site as described in the easement agreement.
