A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Office of Economic Opportunity in the amount of \$151,950 to supplement the county-wide drug rehabilitation program.

WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Opportunity has funds available for programs designed to treat drug dependent persons and to thereby reduce the problems related to drug abuse; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Seattle jointly sponsored and received approval of a grant from the National Institute of Mental Health for a county-wide drug rehabilitation program administered through the Center for Addiction Services; and

WHEREAS, this grant would supplement said program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

- 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Office of Economic Opportunity on behalf of King County.
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Office of Economic Opportunity.
- 3. The King County Mental Health/Mental Retardation
 Director is hereby named the authorized correspondent for King
 County and is further authorized to furnish such additional
 information and documents as may be required by the granting
 agency as specified in Section 1.
- 4. The United States of America, Department of Justice, is hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
