12 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to conduct
13 a systematic review of all active nonsupport cases pending in
14 the Office of the King County Prosecuting Attorney, and;

15 WHEREAS, this grant would enable follow-up or corrective
16 action and diversion from the criminal justice system of those
17 nonsupport cases which may be more appropriately pursued through
18 civil and administrative procedures;

24 directed to file and execute such application and contracts
25 as are required by the State;

26 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office
27 is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is
28 further authorized to furnish such additional information and
29 documents as may be required by the State;

30 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
31 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
32 implementation of the project.
