

11 pertinent administrative determinations, such funds cannot  
12 be used until a responsible local agency has given assurances  
13 satisfactory to the Secretary of the Army that it will:

14 a. Furnish without cost to the United States all lands,  
15 easements, disposal areas, rights-of-way and rights-of-entry  
16 necessary for construction of the project, including gravel  
17 sources, and perform all necessary alterations to utilities; and

18 b. Hold the United States free from damages due to the  
19 construction and subsequent maintenance of the project; and

20 c. Maintain and operate the project works after construc-  
21 tion, in accordance with regulations prescribed by the  
22 Secretary of the Army; and

23 d. Prevent any encroachment on the completed work; and

24 e. Remove and replace fences; and

25 f. Seed the project areas after completion.

26 WHEREAS, The King County Council is empowered by the laws  
27 of the State of Washington to furnish the local cooperation above  
28 set forth, and to levy taxes in the amounts necessary to fulfill  
29 the terms of cooperation;
