

MOTION

1 A MOTION authorizing application for funding
2 assistance for flood control on Green River,
3 JOB NO. GR-72-1, in King County, Washington,
4 to the United States Army Corps of Engineers
5 as provided by the Flood Control Act of 1936.

6 WHEREAS, The United States has made available funds for
7 a project for levee repair on Green River in King County, Wash-
8 ington, substantially as shown on Drawing E-12-7-187 (Exhibit A),
9 dated 14 March 1972, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

10 WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of the Flood
11 Control Act, approved 22 June 1936 (33 USC Section 701C), and
12 pertinent administrative determinations, such funds cannot
13 be used until a responsible local agency has given assurances
14 satisfactory to the Secretary of the Army that it will:

15 a. Furnish without cost to the United States all lands,
16 easements, disposal areas, rights-of-way and rights-of-entry
17 necessary for construction of the project, including gravel
18 sources, and perform all necessary alterations to utilities; and

19 b. Hold the United States free from damages due to the
20 construction and subsequent maintenance of the project; and

21 c. Maintain and operate the project works after con-
22 struction, in accordance with regulations prescribed by the
23 Secretary of the Army; and

24 d. Prevent any encroachment on the completed work; and

25 e. Remove and replace fences; and

26 f. Seed the project areas after completion.

27 WHEREAS, The King County Council is empowered by the
28 laws of the State of Washington to furnish the local cooperation
29 above set forth, and to levy taxes in the amounts necessary to
30 fulfill the terms of cooperation;

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

32 1. That the County does hereby assume and agree to perform
33 the above-named obligations;

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator for King County is hereby designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by said agency;
