1 A MOTION authorizing application to the U.S.  
2 Office of Economic Opportunity to fund an  
3 Intergovernmental Policy Task Force as pro-  
4 vided by 42 U.S.C. 2781 Economic Opportunity  
5 Act of 1964, Title II as amended (P.L. 88-452)

6 WHEREAS, the United States Office of Economic Opportunity is  
7 authorized to make grants under 42 U.S.C. 2781, Economic Oppor-  
8 tunity Act of 1964, Title II as amended, and,

9 WHEREAS, King County recognizes the need to improve coopera-  
10 tion and increase communication between the County, the City of  
11 Seattle and the State of Washington with respect to planning,  
12 budgeting and implementing federal grant programs within the  
13 Seattle-King County area, and

14 WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Policy Task Force would  
15 provide a means to achieve such cooperation and increase com-  
16 munication between the County, the City and State.

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of King County:

18 1. That the County Executive is authorized to execute and  
19 file an application with the U.S. Office of Economic Opportunity  
20 for said grant assistance;

21 2. That the County Executive is authorized to execute any  
22 agreements between King County and other cooperating public  
23 bodies to effect the purposes and intent of this motion;

24 3. That the County Executive is authorized and directed  
25 to execute such contracts as are required by the U.S. Office  
26 of Economic Opportunity;

27 4. That the proposed Intergovernmental Policy Group is in  
28 accordance with the long range planning needs of King County  
29 and that should such application be approved, King County will  
30 undertake such coordinated planning functions;

31 5. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated  
32 as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information  
33

1 and to furnish such documents as may be required by the U.S.  
2 Office of Economic Opportunity.
