1 A MOTION authorizing application to the U. S.  
2 Department of Commerce, Economic Development  
3 Administration, United States of America, for  
4 a grant to assist in the construction of a storm  
5 drainage system in the Sunset Park area, 26th S.  
6 and S. 132nd, under the terms of Public Law  
7 89-136 as amended, and assuring the Economic  
8 Development Administration of timely and successful  
9 completion of project when funded. (#2PW258)

10 WHEREAS, under the provisions of Public Law 89-136, as  
11 amended, grant funds have been made available through the U.S.  
12 Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, to  
13 private or public nonprofit organizations or associations  
14 to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects.

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized  
17 to execute and file an application on behalf of King County,  
18 Washington, with the U. S. Department of Commerce, Economic  
19 Development Administration, for a grant to aid in the construction  
20 of a storm drainage system in the Sunset Parks area, 26th S.  
21 and S. 132nd. The County Executive is hereby authorized to  
22 execute such contracts as the Economic Development Administration  
23 may require.

24 2. That the United States of America, Department of  
25 Commerce, is hereby assured full compliance with such regulations  
26 effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

27 3. That assurance is made to the Economic Development  
28 Administration that every effort will be made to successfully  
29 complete the construction of the project at a cost not greater  
30 than approved for funding. However, if such changes do occur,  
31 prior approval will be received from said Economic Development  
32 Administration.

33 4. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated  
as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information  
and to furnish such documents as may be required by the U. S.  
Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administrator.
