A MOTION directing the County Executive to take immediate steps to implement consolidation of the Seattle Police and King County Department of Public Safety crime laboratories with the intent of establishing a regional facility.

WHEREAS, the Seattle Police Department has announced its intention to expand its crime lab, and

WHEREAS, King County has offered space in the King County Court House for consideration as a site for a consolidated, or regional lab, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has located a drug control assistance unit in conjunction with the Seattle facility and has further indicated its support for locating a regional crime laboratory in the Seattle area, and

WHEREAS, a consolidated facility will vastly improve police laboratory services available to the County and all local jurisdiction therein, and

WHEREAS, these jurisdictions have demonstrated their intention of working together through the formation of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council of King County, and

WHEREAS, it is essential that a decision be reached expeditiously in order to maximize the benefits of consolidation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby directed to join with the Mayor of the City of Seattle in taking immediate steps to implement consolidation of the Seattle Police Department and King County Department of Public Safety crime laboratories, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of King County hereby joins with the City Council of the City of Seattle in inviting other
