

SUBSTITUTE MOTION
NO. 900

1 A MOTION endorsing the Metropolitan transit plan.

2
3 WHEREAS, at the September 19, 1972, election, the voters of
4 the County will be asked to vote on a proposition relating to
5 public transportation: the approval of a County-wide transit plan
6 prepared by the Puget Sound Governmental Conference for the
7 Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (the "Metropolitan transit
8 plan"); and

9 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan transit plan serves substantially
10 all of the commuter area and provides the tax support necessary to
11 improve transit operation throughout the County, including new
12 electric trolleys in the City; and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council believes that it is in the best
14 interests of the residents of the County that the Metropolitan
15 transit plan be approved,

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY the Council of King County:

17 That the Council finds that the Metropolitan transit plan
18 will provide improved transit service for the whole County and new
19 electric trolleys for Seattle, and hereby wholeheartedly endorses
20 the Metropolitan transit plan to be submitted to all the voters of
21 King County on September 19, 1972, by the Municipality of
22 Metropolitan Seattle, and urges a "yes" vote on this proposition.
