A MOTION indicating the Council's approval of the reclassification of property belonging to Harry D. Fletcher, from SE to CG, application for which is designated by the Department of Planning File 308-72-P.

WHEREAS, the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in this matter has been appealed, and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the written appeal arguments and the report on the subject reclassification and makes the following findings and conclusions:

Findings

- 1. Subject property fronts on a major arterial highway near an intersection with a secondary arterial roadway.
- 2. Business and commercial zoning was approved for portions of the subject property in 1959, 1963 and 1967.
- 3. Business uses were established on portions of the subject property pursuant to the above mentioned zoning.
- Subject property and adjacent properties are not prime residential land.

Conclusions

- 1. The proposed reclassification of subject property from SE to CG conforms to the intent of the Comprehensive Plan policies related thereto.
- The proposed reclassification would not be unreasonably incompatible with, nor detrimental to, affected properties and the general public, and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes therefrom the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's decision recommending such denial was based on an error in judgment,
